

60 Second HWS JustFACTS Surveys

The *60 Second JustFACTS Surveys* are anonymous surveys designed by the JustFACTS team that ask 5-6 short questions on a topic of interest to the HWS community. Survey invitations are delivered by electronic mail to every student on campus or a specified subpopulation. Data collection lasts for approximately 5 days. The web based survey is designed to work on smart phones or on a computer with a web browser.

Selected Results

- 91% of HWS students believe it is right to intervene if they witness a student making continued sexual advances or continuing to "hit on" another student who doesn't want it.
- 73% of HWS students are offended when they hear sexist comments and cat calls among fellow students.
- 96% of HWS students would speak with a friend if the friend was in an unhealthy relationship.
- 96% of HWS students believe one should immediately stop any sexual advances when a date says no to sexual activity.
